


Declaration of Compliance

Wouter Witzel EuroValve B.V., hereby certifies that our Butterfly valves, actuators and associated products as delivered, are in compliance with the following Regulations, Directives and their amendments:

REACH	Regulation EC 1907/2006, Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern, Substances listed in Annex XIV, Substances listed in Annex XVII (including asbestos). Note: WW EuroValve is downstream user and importer of articles.
RoHS + RoHS 2	Directive 2002/95/EC and Directive 2011/65/EC about the Restriction of Hazardous Substances: cadmium, hexavalent chromium, lead (Pb), mercury and two bromine containing flame retardants: PBB (polybrominated biphenyls) and PBDE (polybrominated diphenil ethers) in electronic products.
